FIRST AID

GENERAL INFORMATION

GroTea™ is a multifunctional spray adjuvant developed to provide the benefits of a methylated seed oil, surfactant, and water conditioning agent. **GroTea** acts as a canopy penetrating agent, deposition aid, penetrant, spreader, and evaporation reduction agent in liquid spray mixtures by modifying the spray solution, resulting in a more even and uniform spray deposit. In addition, **GroTea** can adjust the spray solution to a pH of 4-5, addressing water quality issues with carbonates/bicarbonates. Care must be taken in treating sensitive crops during periods when plants are subjected to drought stress, high temperatures, and high humidity.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

REFER TO PESTICIDE LABEL FOR SPECIFIC CROP USE AND APPLICATION RATES. Prior to use, read and follow all directions on this label and on the label of the pesticide being used. The pesticide manufacturer's label for specific usages and restrictions have precedence over DIRECTIONS FOR USE referred to on this label. Prior to the addition of **GroTea** to spray tank mixes or prior to the use of **GroTea** where an oil-based adjuvant is not specifically recommended but not prohibited by the manufacturer, the user or application advisor must have experience with the combination or must have conducted a jar and phytotoxicity trial. **GroTea** may be applied by Ground, CDA, or Aerial equipment. In most applications, use enough **GroTea** to allow for uniform wetting and deposition of the spray onto the plant surface without undue runoff. Always add **GroTea** last to the spray solution and provide good agitation.

Ground Applications: Use 0.5 - 1.0% v/v or 1 pint per acre.

Aerial and Low Volume CDA Applications: 6 to 8 fluid ounces per 1-5 gallons of spray solution per acre.

Buffering and pH Adjustment: For most applications a use rate of 0.5 - 1.0% v/v will be sufficient. A jar test should be performed for specific tank mixes and water sources that will affect spray solution pH.

Note: Do not mix with oxidizing agents unless oxidizing agents are in solution.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store product locked up and in original container away from pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed, and keep container tightly closed when not in use. Take care to prevent water from being introduced to the contents of this container. Keep away from sparks, flame, static electricity, or other ignition sources. Shake well before use and keep from freezing. Avoid storage below 50° F. If **GroTea** is stored below 50° F, it may become cloudy and thicken. **GroTea** will return to its normal, clear fluid state above 50° F.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Triple rinse container and pour rinsate into spray tank. Do not reuse container. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal. The Agricultural Container Recycling Council (ACRC) operates the nation recycling program.
