Recipients will be chosen by an independent committee supervised by the lowa College Student Aid Commission.

Scholarship Requirements

- Applicant and/or parent (guardian) must be a voting member (Class A) in good standing of Landus, account number required.
- Applicant must be a high school senior graduating in the spring of the 2025/2026 school year.
- Applicant must have a cumulative high school grade point average of 2.5 or greater on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must pursue a career in an agriculture or life sciences field of study attending the accredited post-secondary school of their choosing.
- Dependents of directors and officers of Landus are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- The application must be postmarked or submitted online on Landus' website no later than *Friday, February 27, 2026* in order to be considered for the award.
